Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Gaillardia x grandiflora</i>
Protection Status:	Right Asserted; COPF Open.
USDA Zone:	Estimate: USDA Zone 5-9. (-20°F or -28°C). Currently testing.
Bloom:	Single elegant red flowers. One row of petals, carried on very strong stems. Blooms are colorfast & age well. Blooms over an exceptionally long period.
Bloom Time:	Early spring – fall. Blooms non-stop in UK!
Foliage:	Fresh, gray green, hairy foliage.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 16" x 14"
Propagation:	Rooted cuttings / Softwood cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established.
Uses:	Containers, beds, borders.

Approximate Finishing Time

Quart:	6-8 weeks from a 72 cell.
Gallon:	8-10 weeks from a 72 cell.
