Gaillardia 'Sunset Mexican'

Key Features

- ✓ Two rows of flat petals, 50:50 watermelon pink & cream/yellow.

Characteristics

Genus & Species: Gaillardia x grandiflora (Code: G817-2)

Protection Status: Right Asserted; COFP Open.

USDA Zone: Estimate: USDA Zone 5-9. (-20°F or -28°C). Currently testing.

Bloom: Two rows of flat petals, 50:50 watermellon pink & cream/yellow. Blooms are colorfast &

age well. Blooming over an exceptionaly long period.

Bloom Time: Early spring—fall. Blooms non-stop in UK!

Foliage: Fresh gray green hairy foliage. **Habit:** Compact mounding habit 16" x 16"

Propagation: Root Cuttings / Softwood cuttings / Tissue Culture. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun, well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Drought tolerant once established.

Uses: Containers, beds, borders.

Approximate Finishing Time

Quart: 6-8 weeks from a 72 cell.
Gallon: 8-10 weeks from a 72 cell.

Closest Variety: G. 'Burgundy'

Key Differences:

- √ 'Sunset Mexican' tight compact habit vs. more open habit.
- ✓ 'Sunset Mexican' higher bud count vs. lower bud count.
- √ 'Sunset Mexican' longer flowering period vs. shorter period.
