

# Gaillardia 'Sunset Sunrise'



## Key Features

- ✓ Two rows of flat petals, orange/amber in color.
- ✓ Exceptionally floriferous over a very period.
- ✓ A gorgeous impulse plant.

## Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Gaillardia x grandiflora</i> (Code: G724-2)
<b>Protection Status:</b>	Right Asserted; COFP Open.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	Estimate: USDA Zone 5-9. (-20°F or -28°C). Currently testing.
<b>Bloom:</b>	Two rows of flat petals, orange/orange in color. Blooms are colorfast & age well. Blooming over an exceptionally long period.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Early spring– fall. Blooms non-stop in UK!
<b>Foliage:</b>	Fresh gray green hairy foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact mounding habit 16" x 16"
<b>Propagation:</b>	Root Cuttings / Softwood cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun, well-drained soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Drought tolerant once established.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, beds, borders.

## Approximate Finishing Time

<b>Quart:</b>	<b>6-8 weeks from a 72 cell.</b>
<b>Gallon:</b>	<b>8-10 weeks from a 72 cell.</b>

**Closest Variety:** G. 'Burgundy'

**Key Differences:**

- ✓ 'Sunset Sunrise' tight compact habit **vs.** more open habit.
- ✓ 'Sunset Sunrise' higher bud count **vs.** lower bud count.
- ✓ 'Sunset Sunrise' longer flowering period **vs.** shorter period.
