Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Leucanthemum superbum</i> (Code: L60)
Protection Status:	U.S. Plant Patent 23,873
USDA Zone:	Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Many layers of fine fringed petals pure white in color with contrasting deep golden centers carried on very strong stems. Blooms become fuller with age.
Bloom Time:	Early-Mid-summer and then repeating in fall.
Foliage:	Mid-dark green, ovate foliage.
Habit:	Tight clumping habit. 36" x 18".
Propagation:	Root cuttings / Tip cuttings / Tissue culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Well-drained soil in full sun. Trim back after summer blooming to encourage new growth & repeat fall blooming.
Additional Comments:	Improved disease resistance. A robust drought resistant perennial once established. Wind resistant. Great for picking.
Uses:	Pots & Containers, Garden Border, Modern landscape, Long-lasting Cut Flower.

Approximate Finishing Time

Quart:	6-8 weeks from a 72 cell.
Gallon:	8-10 weeks from a 72 cell.

Closest Variety: L. 'Goldrush'

- ✓ 'Real Galaxy' higher bud count **vs.** lower bud count.
- ✓ 'Real Galaxy' longer flowering period **vs.** shorter period.
